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to severe injuries such as lacerations hip'

May 31st, 2020 - management once a transient loss of consciousness event has been ruled out it is important to plete a full falls risk assessment this is indicated in order to identify any causative features especially as older people are likely to have multiple co existing risk factors'

April 14th, 2020 - worldwide 30 of people aged 65 years or older who are living in the munity fall each year and among people aged 85 years or older this proportion increases to nearly 40 1 2 falls frequently have serious consequences in this population with conitant effects on the health care system falls are defined in numerous ways one monly used definition is that of the world health'

**'6 age related changes that increase senior fall risk and**

May 31st, 2020 - seniors are at high risk for serious falls the gradual physical changes of aging add up to increased fall risk for older adults in fact the cdc says that people aged 65 have a greater than 25 chance of falling and if someone falls once their chance of falling again doubles meaning there's over 50 chance of a second fall this is serious because falls are a leading cause of lost'

April 23rd, 2020 - over a quarter of a million falls are reported by the uk hospitals each year predominantly harming older patients whose vulnerability to falling arises from a plex interaction of risk factors including impaired mobility dementia delirium medication and the effects of long term and acute illness'

May 28th, 2020 - the prevention and management of falls in older people is a key government target outlined in the national service framework for older people department of health 2001 falls are a major cause of disability and the leading cause of mortality due to injury in people over 75 in the uk'

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
